# HOW SNACKS IMPACT OUR CHILDREN'S HEALTH From Nurse Annie

### **Nutrition**



When the right foods are offered at the right times, snacks can play an important role in managing kids' hunger and boosting nutrition. A well-timed snack can even out spikes in hunger and provide energy boost between meals.

For picky eaters of all ages, snacks can be added insurance that they're getting necessary nutrients.

# Academic Performance

Nutrition and academic performance are linked. Healthy snacking provides your child's brain with the nutrients it needs



Children who snack on healthy foods like fruit perform better in school, according to a study published in the journal Medicine. On the flip side, children who snack on sugary foods (candy, donuts), sugar-sweetened beverages and other unhealthy foods like processed treats (Doritos) and fast food (pizza, french fries) don't perform as well academically.

### Mood



Healthy snacking contributes to your child's emotional well-being. Snacking on fruit lowers anxiety, boosts mood and lowers emotional distress, say researchers of a study in the journal Frontiers in Nutrition. Scientists found that snacking on potato chips increases fatigue, poor mood states and cognitive difficulties.

### **Energy and Focus**

According to the Women's diet has a significant effect food and foods with high and the ability to



and Children's Health Network, on children's study habits. Junk sugar content deplete energy levels concentrate for extended periods of

time. Energy and focus are especially crucial for school-age children.



### Lifelong preferences

Eating a lot of processed food during childhood makes it hard to eat healthy in later life as childhood food habits solidify by adulthood. This makes it less likely their palates will later savor the less complicated and less spicy flavors of ordinary food.

• **Read serving size information:** What looks like a small package can contain 2 or more servings — which means double or even triple the amounts of fat, calories, and sugar shown on the label.





### • Be skeptical of food claims:

- o If the fat has been eliminated or cut back, the amount of sugar in the food might have increased to keep that food tasting good.
- O Just because something is "all natural" or "pure" doesn't necessarily mean that it's nutritious. For example, "all natural" juice drinks or sodas can be filled with sugar

(which is, after all, a natural ingredient) but all that sugar means they'll be high in calories and give little nutrition, lacking the fiber of a whole fruit.

• Avoid processed foods and added sugars. Processed foods (made in a factory and sold in bags and boxes) do not have many nutrients and often have a lot of added sugar and salt. In addition, children may become hungry faster after eating processed foods



- **Avoid foods with trans fats** (also called trans fatty acids). Look for terms such as "partially hydrogenated" or "hydrogenated," which indicate the product contains trans fats.

Whole foods such as fruits, vegetables, eggs and cheese are nature's perfect convenience food. These should be your first choice for snacks. Beyond fruits and vegetables, the best snacks are low in sugar, high in protein, are unrefined and/or contain a short list of ingredients.

The best snacks satisfy hunger while helping meet our daily dietary needs. Here are some easy suggestions:

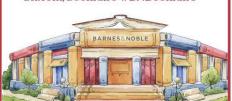

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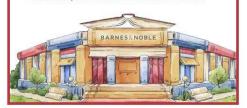

### Dear Parents,

This summer I will be available for tutoring lower school students, (children entering Kindergarten – Grade 3). If you would like your child to continue to work on academic skills throughout the summer or if your child needs support in reading, math or readiness skills and you are looking for a tutor, please contact me at <a href="mailto:mtremblay@spxschool.org">mtremblay@spxschool.org</a>.

I have been trained in the Wilson Reading Program. This is a phonics program designed to reinforce phonics and help the struggling reader learn to internalize the mechanics of reading. Reading comprehension, encoding and decoding are some of the skills that will be reinforced. Beginning readers will continue to learn the mechanics of phonics. I will review letter sounds and sight words, as well as play games that will reinforce reading readiness skills.

I have also been trained in best practice Math strategies such as Number Sense and Subitizing. These approaches help struggling Math students internalize math concepts. I will also reinforce skills and concepts which were taught throughout the school year.

I will be available Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday mornings beginning July 12 through August 18. Please send me an email if you have any questions or would like more information.

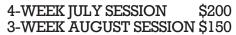
