Registrations will be accepted at our office Mon-Fri , 8:00am - 4:00pm at 424 Route 28 in West Yarmouth or online 24 hours a day

All registrations are accepted on a first come first serve basis. Participation in one session does not guarantee enrollment in any other session.

- The guardian must have proof of residency in Yarmouth to receive the corresponding rate.
- The participant must be the minimum age required for the program by the 1st day of the program. NO exceptions!

Payment:

- Payment in full for program is due prior to start date;
- Make checks payable to "Yarmouth Recreation".
- There is a \$30 fee for returned checks.
- Checks are not accepted within 14 days of a program starting.

Cancellations:

- The Recreation Division reserves the right to cancel or re-schedule programs, events or trips. Every attempt will be made to schedule make-up dates for programs cancelled due to inclement weather.

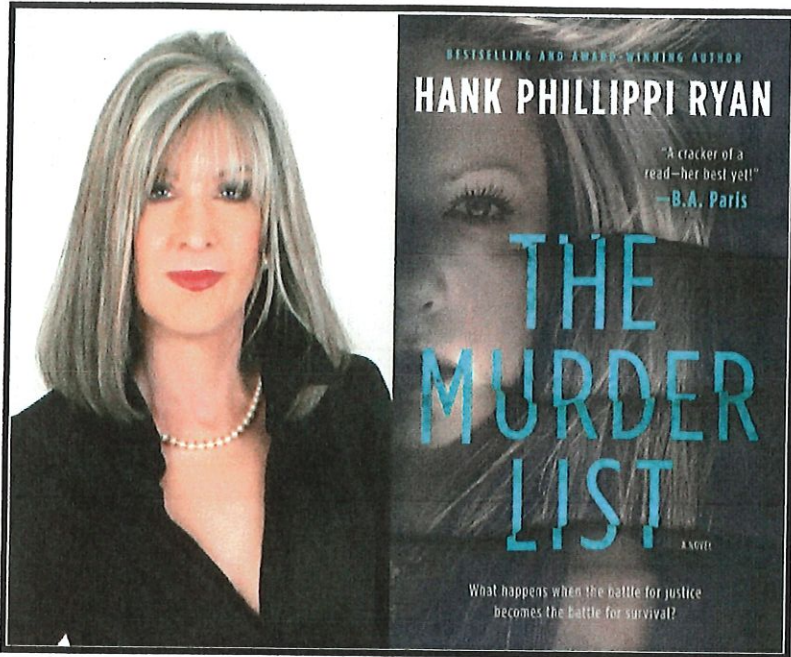
