#### **December Calendar**

Please note that a change will be made to the Dec. calendar. The superintendent has approved adjustments to the Christmas break, and several schools are ending Dec. 18<sup>th</sup> for Christmas. Our goal is to keep students onsite engaged meaningfully, for as long as we possibly can. However, knowing that many students will not attend school on Dec. 23<sup>rd</sup> (the half day) and to provide a little extra break to our staff, school will **NOT BE IN SESSION ON DEC. 23<sup>rd</sup>**.

#### **COVID News**
