COVID UPDATE

As you can see from the COVID letter, we've had a number of positive cases this past week. Fortunately, many students were able to participate in the **Test and Stay Program**. Test and Stay allowed about 40 unvaccinated students to test- and remain in school- instead of quarantining at home. In about twenty other instances, students were exempt from testing, due to their vaccination status. Thank You to parents, for your understanding and cooperation in all our COVID-related efforts. Thank You,

Mrs. Shaw and Mrs. Agurkis, for keeping on top of cases, symptoms, contacts, and tests. A special "Bravo!" to two additional staff members, Mrs. Werner and Mrs. Hietsch, who completed Test and Stay training, and have donned the blue gowns, braved the elements, and helped collect the specimens and conduct the tests. It's taken a village to work with COVID!

If your child has been vaccinated, please send that info along to our nurse, Mrs. Agurkis. This information will help us internally with any future contract tracing. A child who has received two vaccinations is not required to test and is not considered a close contact of a positive individual if:

the vaccinations were completed at least to weeks prior to exposure the child is not showing any symptoms

School and Illness: should your child stay home?

The following guidelines will help you decide whether or not your child is too ill to attend school

CHILD IS TOO ILL to attend school if he/she has any of these signs or symptoms:

- Seems **very tired** and needs bed rest (this is common with flu and COVID)
- Has vomiting or diarrhea
- Is short of breath or wheezing
- Persistent cough
- Muscle/body aches
- New loss of taste or smell
- Has distracting **pain** from earache, headache, sore throat, coughing or recent injury
- Has yellow or green **discharge** from eye(s)
- On antibiotics for less than 24 hours for an infection

FEVER

Your child should not attend school if his/her temperature is equal to or greater than 100.0 degrees within the last 24 hours. According to the Department of Public Health, children must remain home until they are **fever free for 24 hours WITHOUT** fever reducing medication.

CONTAGIOUS DISEASE

Your child should stay home from school if he/she has a contagious disease. A contagious disease is one that can be spread by close contact with a person or object. Examples are flu, COVID, vomiting, diarrhea, strep throat, Coxsackie Virus "Hand foot and mouth disease" and conjunctivitis "pink eye".

Why it's important to keep sick children home from school

Your child won't learn: If a child is feeling sick they are unlikely to be able to focus and learn if they are sent to school.

It could spread the illness to others: Your child could infect other children or teachers if they are still contagious. If some of these people are immunocompromised, then your child may be putting them at risk for severe illness or other complications.

Too much activity slows your child's recovery: If your child goes to school when they are sick, then they may be losing out on time to recover, which could increase the time that they are sick.

When in doubt, check with the school. It's also important to report the details of your student's illness so the school staff can check to see if others might have been exposed to your child.

Please be sure to complete the appropriate over the counter medication consent. Thank you to those who have already done so!
