## January 22, 2020

Interim grades closed today, with Interim Reports coming next Wed. On Friday, the 31<sup>st</sup>, we will have Parent-Teacher conferences. If you want a conference with a teacher, please request one. Teachers will also conference with parents/guardians of students with whom they have a concern and have requested a meeting. After-care will be open on the 31<sup>st</sup>- but only for those who have signed up!

Speaking about grades- a couple of notes.

First, some students and parents are stressing over grades as "low" as 90, 92, and even 95. We have witnessed an increased focus this year on whether a student is achieving Honor Roll, or High Honors. I am very glad that students are aiming high however, our goal is that each student works hard and performs his/her personal BEST. The focus on Honor Roll has led to a greater level of stress among some students. I have spent time with students whose averages are A's and B's who feel they are "failing" because they may not achieve Honors or High Honors. This level of stress is unsettling. I have advised students they should aim high- but that learning to work, and do their best is ultimately more important than an Honor Roll certificate.

Secondly, teachers are expected to work towards posting a grade per week per subject area for each student. Grades are to be posted in a timely manner, providing feedback regarding student performance that is meaningful. This will not happen *every* week-obviously not vacation weeks or a week like Catholic Schools Week, when we are focused on many non-academic endeavors. If you are checking the portal, and do not see grades for your student, you can always reach out to the teacher to find out why.
