Dear Parent/Guardian,

As required by State Law, the annual Postural Screening will be performed during the week of March 25th. The purpose of this is to screen for early signs of possible spinal problems in students in **grades 5 through 8**. This screening is not a diagnostic service but rather a program to identify those who may need further evaluation. This screening may not be waived except on religious grounds. Students with a physician's evaluation of their spine on file in the Health Office dated within the last 12 months will be exempt.

If your child has any unusual findings, you will be notified by letter and asked to have your child evaluated by his/her physician as a precaution. The majority of students will exhibit no findings.

Female students are asked to wear a two-piece swimsuit, a halter top, or sports bra under their gym clothes to school on the day of the screening. This type of clothing permits a more accurate observation of the back. Boys and girls will be screened separately.

Fifth graders will view a brief video followed by a question and answer period in order to allay any apprehensions they may have. If you have any further questions regarding this program, please feel free to call the Health Office.
